Dear Exhibitor,

I am happy to extend to you an invitation to exhibit at HUNTSPEX 2010 in Huntsville, Alabama next June 5 & 6. We are an open exhibition and are pleased to accept exhibits in any collecting field. Because of Huntsville's history and reputation as the "Rocket City", our show theme typically observes a space related anniversary and we are always especially delighted to welcome exhibits with a space related topic. This year's show theme will celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Marshall Space Flight Center at Redstone Arsenal.

HUNTSPEX is the premier stamp show in Northern Alabama and 2010 will be the 43rd anniversary of our show. The Huntsville Philatelic Exposition features a stamp bourse, a show cover with matching cachet and special philatelic cancellation, a USPS Postal Station, as well as a show theme souvenir sheet which is given free to all show visitors.

With a typical presence of a dozen or so regional stamp dealers and show visitors from all over Northern Alabama and South Central Tennessee, HUNTSPEX has become the region's biggest stamp collector's marketplace. We have had the pleasure to host many of the same dealers year after year and several have built special relationships with local collectors.

Huntsville has many attractions for those who may not want to spend all their time at the show. The U.S. Space and Rocket Center features exhibits of Apollo, Mercury and Space Shuttle spacecraft as well as spectacular shows in the Spacedome Omnimax theater. At the Huntsville Depot you can discover Alabama's railway history as you climb aboard historic locomotives and read graffiti written by Civil War soldiers. And there's always something beautiful growing at the Huntsville Botanical Garden, an exquisite 110-acre site with stunning floral collections, inviting woodland paths and broad grassy meadows.
