Notes from last month's meeting:

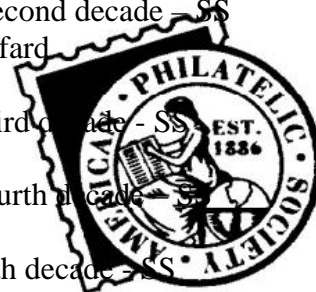
